Jesus Loves Us All



Jesus loves ALL the little children and so should we!

Scrip- "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:34-35

This morning if I was in church I would have a bag of "Dum-dums." As you can know, "Dum-dums" come in many different flavors. There are lemon, cherry, grape, watermelon, orange, and butterscotch to name just a few. I sometimes give "Dum-dums" to the children who come to Sunday School. One thing I have noticed is that when I allow the children to choose the flavor they want, some children are very picky about which flavor they choose. The favorite flavor seems to be blue raspberry. I don't think it is because kids like the taste, I think it is because they like the way it turns their mouth blue! Whenever I let the children choose, I always wind up with all of the butterscotch left when all of the other flavors are gone. For some reason, children seldom ever choose the butterscotch suckers.

I don't know why the children don't like butterscotch. I guess butterscotch is a little bit different. Maybe it isn't quite as sweet as grape or cherry, or some of the other flavors, or maybe they just don't like the color of the paper wrapper. Do you know what I do with the leftover butterscotch suckers? I eat them myself, because I love all the flavors!

These "Dum-dums" remind me of children. Have you ever noticed that when children play games, some children are always the last to be chosen? Maybe they are just a little bit different or maybe their skin is a different color. For some reason, the other children just won't choose them.

We all need to remember that Jesus loves ALL the children and he said that you and I should do the same. Jesus said, "As I have loved you, so must you love one another." Have you ever been the one who was left out? It isn't a very good feeling, but if you are ever the one that feels left out, you can know that Jesus loves you just as much as He loves the other children.

Dear Lord, help us to remember that you have told us to love one another just as you have loved us. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.



A note from the Finance Committee,

While we will discontinue with public worship for the next three weeks. The expenses for operating the church will not. The bills will continue to come in and our staff still needs to be paid. You will find four offering envelopes included with this mailing. We ask that you remain consistent with your giving through these unprecedented times so that our financial situation at Faith Church does not deteriorate. The envelopes have prepaid postage so no stamp is required. On our website, PayPal is another convenient way to you to remit your offering to the church.

If you feel more comfortable delivering your offering in person, please call ahead to confirm that someone is in the office to accept your funds. Bev has indicated that she plans to spend time in the office but her hours may be reduced under the circumstances. If you have automatic payments scheduled for your financial support to Faith Church, we ask that you continue with that method.

Quick Summary of Feb 2020 Financial Information

Operating Fund – Feb receipts were \$22,353; disbursements were \$25,872 for net disbursements of\$3,519. Year to date receipts were \$37,126; disbursements were \$50,484 for net disbursements of \$13,258 The Operating Fund balance was \$20,307 at January 1, 2020 and was \$6,949 at Feb 29, 2020.

Building Fund – Jan receipts were \$521; disbursements were \$1,020 for net disbursements of \$499. Year to date receipts were \$1030; disbursements were \$10,040 for net disbursements of \$9,010. The Building Fund balance was \$16,285 at January 1, 2020 and was \$7,275 at Feb 29, 2020.

Mortgage Balance – The mortgage balance on Feb 29, 2020 is \$60,944. Payments of \$1,020 (principal and interest at 4.750 percent) are due on the 25th of each month. The final payment is due September 25, 2020. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.

Unrestricted Cash Balances – total \$73,466 as of Feb 29, 2020. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.
