net disbursements of \$2,900 The Operating Fund balance was \$6,196 at January 1, 2019 and was \$3,296 at June 30, 2019.

Building Fund – June receipts were \$649; disbursements were \$1020 for net disbursements of \$371. Year to date receipts were \$7,766; disbursements were \$6,120 for net receipts of \$1,646. The Building Fund balance was \$9,965 at January 1, 2019 and was \$11,607 at June 30, 2019.

Carpeting Fund – June receipts were \$50. There were no disbursements. Year to date receipts were \$215. There were no disbursements. The Carpeting Fund balance was \$434 at January 1, 2019 and was \$649 at June 30, 2019.

Unrestricted Cash Balances – total \$72,332 as of June 30, 2019. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Restricted Cash Balances – Pynch Memorial Fund – is \$10,065 as of June 30, 2019. Principal of \$10,000 is to be maintained forever. Earnings on the account are to be used for kitchen supplies and library materials. The account is held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Mortgage Balance – The mortgage balance on June 30, 2019 is \$74,807. Payments of \$1,020 (principal and interest at 4.750 percent) are due on the 25th of each month. The final payment is due September 25, 2020. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.

Scripture: Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ Loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. Ephesians 5:1-2

Do you have a role model? "What's a role model?" you might be asking. Well, a role model is a person that you respect, admire, and want to be like in some way. It might be a famous person such as a great athlete or a movie star. It might be someone you know personally like your favorite teacher. It might be a religious leader. It could even be your mom, dad, or a brother or sister. Whether we realize it or not, we all have role models.

I am going to show you some pictures of people that most of you will probably recognize and you can tell me whether or not you think that person would be a good role model. (Show the pictures and give the children the opportunity to talk about them.) It is important that we choose our role models carefully, isn't it? If we choose someone as our role model just because he or she is rich and famous, we will very likely be disappointed.

If you are looking for a role model, here is a good place to look. (Hold up your Bible.) In the book of Ephesians, Paul said to the people in the church at Ephesus, "Imitate God in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us."

What are some of the things that make Jesus the perfect role model for us to follow? He is:

Kind Loving Tenderhearted Forgiving Patient

Well, we could go on and on, couldn't we? Jesus is our perfect role model because he is God's perfect Son who brings salvation to all who obey him.


