

MISSION MINISTRIES

"One Small Drop" mission was founded on the belief that just one small drop of financial



support can bring a flood of help to the poorest of places in the world. It is entering its 10th and final year. They have grown from assisting 4 women's groups to 11 groups and communities in Tanzania. Their sustainable projects have included potatoes, pigs, avocados, chickens, tea, beans, cows, batik dying, a sewing machine co-op, micro loans, timber trees, and chair rental. New projects are a maize grinding machine, a timber milling machine, bees and honey project, and 4 groups sponsoring orphans' schooling. The HIV/Aids group operates the largest potato project. Because of their project the people are now taken seriously in the

community, treated with dignity, and not shunned. Our FUMC mission fund recently sent \$500 to help purchase school uniforms for some of the orphans. We received the following thank you from Tammie Jo - "Dear Faith Family, I want to express my sincere gratitude for your continued support to One Small Drop and especially for your most recent donation for school uniforms. Because of your kindness 17 children will be able to attend school. I leave July 3rd to head back to Tanzania to deliver your gift. Again, thank you from the bottom of my heart. Blessings, Tammie Jo Berg" Please keep her in your prayers this month. The FUMC Mission Team also thanks you for your support as we seek to serve and share God's love in His world.

We would love to have you serve a meal with us at the Homeless Connections on Friday, July 20th from 7-9 P.M. There is a sign-up sheet on the welcome table in the narthex. Last month so many residents thanked us for bringing all the fresh fruit as part of the meal - they also like the ice cream.

REACHED OUR GOAL

As you know the family ministry set a goal to help the church buy a scrubber. This floor scrubber will help keep our fellowship hall and possibly the gym clean as we continue to use our building for the mission of bring disciples to Christ. Thanks to all you who helped on our "fund raiser event" created baskets for our silent auction, and other donations, we are going to be able to purchase the scrubber. When we all work together and with God's help we can set goals and we are able to achieve.



Quick Summary of May 2018 Financial Information

Operating Fund – May receipts were \$21,101; disbursements were \$20,367 for net receipts of \$734. Year to date receipts were \$104,292; disbursements were \$116,842 for net disbursements of (\$12,550). The Operating Fund balance was \$11,886 at January 1, 2018 and was negative (\$665) at May 31, 2018.

Building Fund – May receipts were \$635; disbursements were \$1,020 for net disbursements of (\$385). Year to date receipts were \$7,789; disbursements were \$5,100 for net receipts of \$2,689. The Building Fund balance was \$3,128 at January 1, 2018 and was \$5,817 at May 31, 2018.

Carpeting Fund – May receipts were \$10. There were no disbursements. Year to date receipts were \$5,238. There were no disbursements. The Carpeting Fund balance was negative (\$5,054) at January 1, 2018 and was \$184 at May 31, 2018.

Unrestricted Cash Balances – total \$71,748 as of May 31, 2018. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Restricted Cash Balances – Pynch Memorial Fund – is \$10,011 as of May 31, 2018. Principal of \$10,000 is to be maintained forever. Earnings on the account are to be used for kitchen supplies and library materials. The account is held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Mortgage Balance – The mortgage balance on May 31, 2018 is \$83,222. Payments of \$1,020 (principal and interest at 4.750 percent) are due on the 25th of each month. The final payment is due September 25, 2020. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.



Theme: Jesus gave us the recipe for happiness — the Beatitudes.

Object: The ingredients for making trail mix. (healthy choice of whole-grain cereal, raisins, dried fruit

like cranberries or banana slices, walnuts or almonds, sunflower or pumpkin seeds, chocolate

Scripture: Scripture: Matthew 5:1-12

Today, we are going to fix a tasty snack treat. Oh boy, that sounds like fun. The first thing we need is a recipe. You know what a recipe is, don't you? A recipe is a set of instructions, including a list of all of the ingredients, that tells you how to prepare a dish. Here is my recipe to make a delicious and healthy trail mix snack (hold up the recipe. And here is a bag with all of the ingredients we will need and a bowl to mix it up in. (Have the ingredients measured and placed in plastic bags ahead of time to make the preparation of the mix go guickly.)


First, we will pour in some nuts, next some raisins. Let's see, next we put in some sunflower seeds, and then some M&Ms. (Continue until all ingredients have been added, commenting about each one.) Well, the trail mix is all finished, so now we have a tasty snack to enjoy at the close of our lesson today.

Did you know that Jesus gave us a recipe for living a happy life? In the book of Matthew, it says, "Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, and he began to teach them." What did he teach them? He taught them a lesson which we call "The Beatitudes." Each one of the beatitudes starts with the words, "Blessed are they. . ." Some translations of the Bible use the word happy instead of blessed. Let's see what Jesus said about what is needed for a happy life full of God's blessings. (Read these from the Bible.)

- Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Blessed are they that mourn, for they shall be comforted.
- Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.
- Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled.
- Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.
- Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
- Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the children of God.
- Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Some of these things that Jesus said make it sound as if following him might sometimes be difficult. But Jesus promised that even when people insult us, say awful things about us, and persecute us because we follow him, we should rejoice and be glad, because we will have great rewards in heaven!

Dear Father, we thank you for the teachings of Jesus. Even though life may not always be easy, we know that if we trust in Jesus, we will be blessed. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.


