



#### **Quick Summary of April 2019 Financial Information**

**Operating Fund** – April receipts were \$20,537; disbursements were \$20,774 for net receipts of \$237. Year to date receipts were \$82,070; disbursements were \$97,407 for net disbursements of \$15,337 The Operating Fund balance was \$6,196 at January 1, 2019 and was (\$9,141) at April 30, 2019.

**Building Fund** – April receipts were \$1,779; disbursements were \$1020 for net reciepts of \$759 Year to date receipts were \$6,073; disbursements were \$4,080 for net receipts of \$1,993. The Building Fund balance was \$9,965 at January 1, 2019 and was \$11,955 at April 30, 2019.

**Carpeting Fund** – April receipts were \$40. There were no disbursements. Year to date receipts were \$145. There were no disbursements. The Carpeting Fund balance was \$434 at January 1, 2019 and was \$579 at April30, 2019.

**Unrestricted Cash Balances** – total \$62,214 as of April 30, 2019. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

**Restricted Cash Balances** – Pynch Memorial Fund – is \$10,057 as of April 30, 2019. Principal of \$10,000 is to be maintained forever. Earnings on the account are to be used for kitchen supplies and library materials. The account is held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

**Mortgage Balance** – The mortgage balance on April 30, 2019 is \$75,557. Payments of \$1,020 (principal and interest at 4.750 percent) are due on the 25th of each month. The final payment is due September 25, 2020. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.

### On the Mountain Top



**Theme:** Mountain top experiences prepare us for the valleys of every day life.

Transfiguration Sunday

**Object:** Some beautiful pictures of mountains

Scripture: After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah."

Mark 9:2-5 (NIV)

Have you ever taken a vacation in the mountains? Of all the vacations that I have ever taken, the ones that I enjoyed the most were the ones that I took to see the mountains in New England because I was with my family. I have seen the mountains in the west and they are have higher peaks.

Why do you think people enjoy vacationing in the mountains? There are several reasons. One reason is that they want to get away from the heat. In the summer months, the heat can become almost unbearable at times. It is refreshing to go up into the mountains where the air is cool. Another reason is to enjoy the beautiful view. When you are down in the valley, it is often difficult to see and appreciate the beauty around you, but from the mountain top, you can clearly see the beauty of the world below. Finally, many people enjoy vacationing in the mountains to get away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life. It is good to get away from the pressure of work and busy schedules, and just sit back and relax. When we are enjoying a get away in the mountains, we sometimes find it hard to go back to our day to day life.

Did you know that Jesus enjoyed getting away for a mountain retreat? The Bible tells us that one day Jesus took Peter, James and John high up into the mountains so that they could be alone. While on the mountain top, Jesus' appearance changed. His clothes became a dazzling white, whiter than any bleach could get them. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking to Jesus. Peter exclaimed, "Teacher, it is wonderful for us to be here! Let's build three shelters -- one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Then a cloud passed over and covered them. From the cloud came a voice saying, "This is my Son, and I love him. Listen to what he says!" Then when they looked again, they saw only Jesus.




