### **Quick Summary of April 2021 Financial Information**

Operating Fund – April receipts were \$27,529; disbursements were \$20,198 for net receipts of \$7,331. Year to date receipts were \$88,442; disbursements were \$95,430 for net disbursements of \$6,988 The Operating Fund balance was \$67,329 at January 1, 2021 and was \$60,340 at April 30, 2021.

Building Fund – April receipts were \$1,361; disbursements were \$1840 for net disbursements of \$479. Year to date receipts were \$7,849; disbursements were \$4290 for net receipts of \$3,559. The Building Fund balance was \$2,275 at January 1, 2021 and was \$5,834 at April 30, 2021.

Carpeting Fund – April receipts were \$0. There were no disbursements. Year to date receipts were \$25. There were no disbursements. The Carpeting Fund balance was \$1,144 at January 1, 2021 and was \$1,169 at April 30, 2021.

Unrestricted Cash Balances – total \$127,937 as of April 30, 2021. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Restricted Cash Balances – Pynch Memorial Fund – is \$10,081 as of April 30, 2021. Principal of \$10,000 is to be maintained forever. Earnings on the account are to be used for kitchen supplies and library materials. The account is held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Mortgage Balance – The mortgage balance on April 30, 2021 is \$39,102. Payments of \$610 are due on the 25th of each month. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.

### **Life Line Screening will be at the church on Thursday, July 29, 2021.**
