Worship Bulletins

We are now using the same format for our bulletins as we did prior to the restrictions. With your bulletin each Sunday you will find a pen and yellow welcome card. Please complete the card and, after the worship service, place it in one of the baskets found in the Narthex along with your giving envelope. The pen is yours to keep.

The ushers have extra yellow cards and giving envelopes if you need extras.

By completing the card, the church office staff are able to keep track of who is coming to worship each Sunday for informational purposes. Also you can use the card to inform the church office of address, phone changes or email changes. Any changes are entered into the computer so that our data base is up to date. On the other side of the card, there is a place for prayer concerns, or other items that you may want to fill out.

The information is entered so that we can run reports as needed and to help when we need to create a new directory. The offering envelopes and cards are separated in the church office with the office staff getting the yellow welcome cards and the offering envelopes are given to the finance team.

Theme Flag Day or Independence Day

Scripture Hebrews 9:22; Isaiah 1:18;

1 Corinthians 6:10; 1 John 1:9



This week we will celebrate Independence Day! That is our country's birthday. This morning I have the American Flag. This is the flag of the United States of America. As you know, our flag is red, white, and blue. Have you ever stopped to think what those colors mean?

Red: Red stands for courage. Many men and women have had the courage to stand up and fight for our country. They have defended our country against our enemies and many have died in the service of our country.

White: White stands for purity. Purity means to do what is right. We hope and pray that our country will always stand for what is right.

Blue: Blue stands for justice. When we pledge allegiance to the flag, we end with the words: "With liberty and justice for all." That means that in our country, everyone should be treated fairly and with respect.

The colors red, white, and blue remind me of our country, but those colors also remind me of Jesus.

Red reminds me of Jesus' blood that was shed when he died on the cross for my sin. That is very important, because the Bible says, "Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness " (Hebrews 9:22).

Blue reminds me of God's faithfulness. The Bible tells us that "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and make us clean" (1 John 1:9). God is faithful to keep His promises.

Red, white, and blue. Yes, I am reminded of our great country, but more importantly, I am reminded of our great Savior, Jesus.
