Dear Christian Friends,

Did you ever wonder why? Why Lord? I know I have. You are not alone.

Mary and Martha could not understand what their Lord was doing. Each said to him (John 11:21, 32), "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." The real statement behind this was, "Lord, we do not understand why you waited so long to come or how you could allow the man you love so much to die. We do not understand how you could allow such sorrow and suffering to devastate our life, when your presence might have stopped it all. Why didn't you come? Now it is too late, because Lazarus has been dead four days!" Jesus simply had one great truth in answer to all of this. He said, in essence, "You may not understand, but I am telling you that if you believe, you will see."

This is not the only time this happened in the Bible. Abraham could not understand why God would ask him to sacrifice his son, but he trusted Him. Moses could not understand why God would require him to stay forty years in the wilderness, but also trusted Him. Joseph could not understand his brothers' cruelty toward him, the false testimony of a treacherous woman, or the long years of unjust imprisonment, but he trusted God and finally he saw His glory in it all.

Maybe there is something in your life that is causing you to question God. Maybe questioning God on the loss of a loved one. Why something bad has happened. Maybe your plans are not turning out the way you would like them to. The blessings that one is looking for are so desperately long in coming.

Or, with all the strange things happening in our world and people's behaviors we have questions. (I know that I do.)

The truth is that we do not have to understand all God's ways of dealing with things. We are not expected to. Just like we do not expect our children to understand everything we do. We simply want them to trust us as parents.

The Good News is that someday you/we too will see the glory of God in the things we do not yet understand! We just have to trust Him!

#### **THANK YOU FROM THE COTS – Wish Program**

The COTS team wanted to thank everyone who helped with items brought in to fill the cot for COTS, and helped with our Campus of change Campaign—to help end homelessness in the Fox Valley. What is the COTS Program of the Fox Valley you may be asking?

The COTS program helps over 60 people every day. A resident of the program recently said “if COTS didn’t exist, I have no clue where I’d be. It doesn’t bear thinking about.”

For our residents, we are the alternative to life on the streets, crashing on a couch, or worse. We are the difference between not knowing where your next night will be spent and having a safe place to call your own, a true home where you wake up in your own bed every day. Our “campus of change” Campaign supports our mission of addressing the root causes of homelessness. Our program focuses on the four core areas shown to be essential to people leaving homelessness behind for good.—Wellness (including mental, physical, and dental health), Education and employment, Permanent social connections, stable housing. Our residents come to us from many different walks of life, from histories of childhood trauma, addiction, chronic physical health issues, lack of access to education services, and other debilitating circumstances. What they share is a desire to make a positive, lasting change in their lives.

The Mission team wants to share with you information about what is going on with the Mission Ministry of this church. The ministry helps in local, state, national, and international projects as you can discover in taking a moment to check out the hallway by the sanctuary. The mission Bulletin board shows all the updated information on the contributions and projects the Mission team is working on. ## Summary August 2017 Financial Information

**Operating Fund** – August receipts were \$16,723; disbursements were \$20,397 for net disbursements of (\$3,674). Year to date receipts were \$177,849; disbursements were \$176,587 for net receipts of \$1,261.

The Operating Fund balance at August 31, 2017 is positive \$19,392.

**Building Fund** – August receipts were \$1,928; disbursements were \$6,170 for net disbursements of (\$4,242).

Year to date receipts were \$14,041; disbursements were \$13,428 for net receipts of \$613. The Building Fund balance at August 31, 2017 is positive \$5,100.

**Carpeting Fund** – August receipts were \$263. Year to date receipts were \$9,344. Year to date disbursements were \$34,985. The first phase of the carpeting project was paid in May 2017. The Carpeting Fund balance at August 31, 2017 is negative (\$19,285).

**Cash Balances** – at August 31, 2017 are checking \$18,852, general savings \$53,442 and Faith Notes sinking fund savings \$8,635. All the accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

**Mortgage Balance** – The mortgage balance on August 31, 2017 was \$89,282.

### **“UPDATED NFORMATION REGARDING OUR CARPET FUND-FUNDRAISING UPDATE**

As we enjoy the new carpet throughout the education wing and the Narthex, we still have a fund established to raise moneys for the second phase of the carpet, and to rebuild the money used to pay off the first phase of the carpet. The cost of the carpet was \$35,984.59, with funds being transferred as follows: \$15,000 from the carpeting fund, \$5,000 from General Capital Improvements, and \$5,000 from the Building Fund.” The bill was paid-in-full, but the balance will remain on the books until the end of the year, when adjustments will be made. Can you help replenish our account? Thank you for your help on this major endeavor. Here is overall we stand on Pay back of the initial carpet install.

Total cost of the carpet	\$35,985
Donations/money transferred	\$25,000
Remainder to pay back	\$8,557.

We are working on the details for lunch before we leave for our adventure.

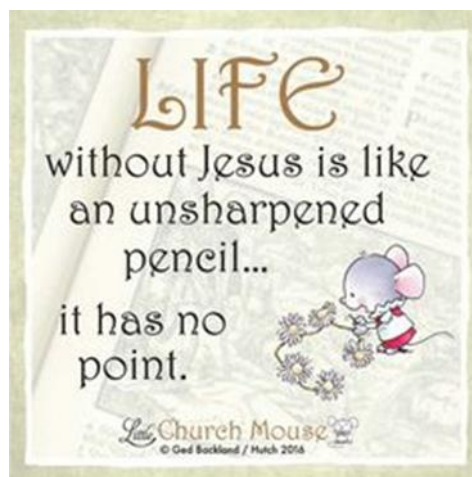

## A Plan for Success



**Theme:** Noah builds an ark.

**Scripture:** This is how you are to build it: The ark is to be 450 feet long, 75 feet wide and 45 feet high.

Make a roof for it and finish the ark to within 18 inches of the top. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks. Genesis 6:15-16 (NIV)

Have you ever put together a model kit ? I have built several models and they are a lot of fun to build. I have built model cars, planes, and boats. Some kits have a lot of parts and are very difficult to build. Some are a little easier. There is one thing that every model kit must have -- instructions! Suppose I were to give you this kit with the instructions, do you think you could build it? Well, you might need some time and a little help, but you could probably do it.

What if I gave you a set of instructions like these (hold up the Noah's Ark plan) and told you I wanted you to build a boat that was 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. Do you think you could do it? You would probably say, "No way! That is bigger than a football field! I can't build a boat that big!"

Well, that is exactly what happened to a man named Noah. I know you have heard the story, but every time I hear it, I learn something new. Maybe you will too.

One day God looked down on the world that he had created and he saw how mean and evil the people had become. It broke his heart to see the way people were acting. "I'm sorry I made them, he said, "I'll get rid of them all."

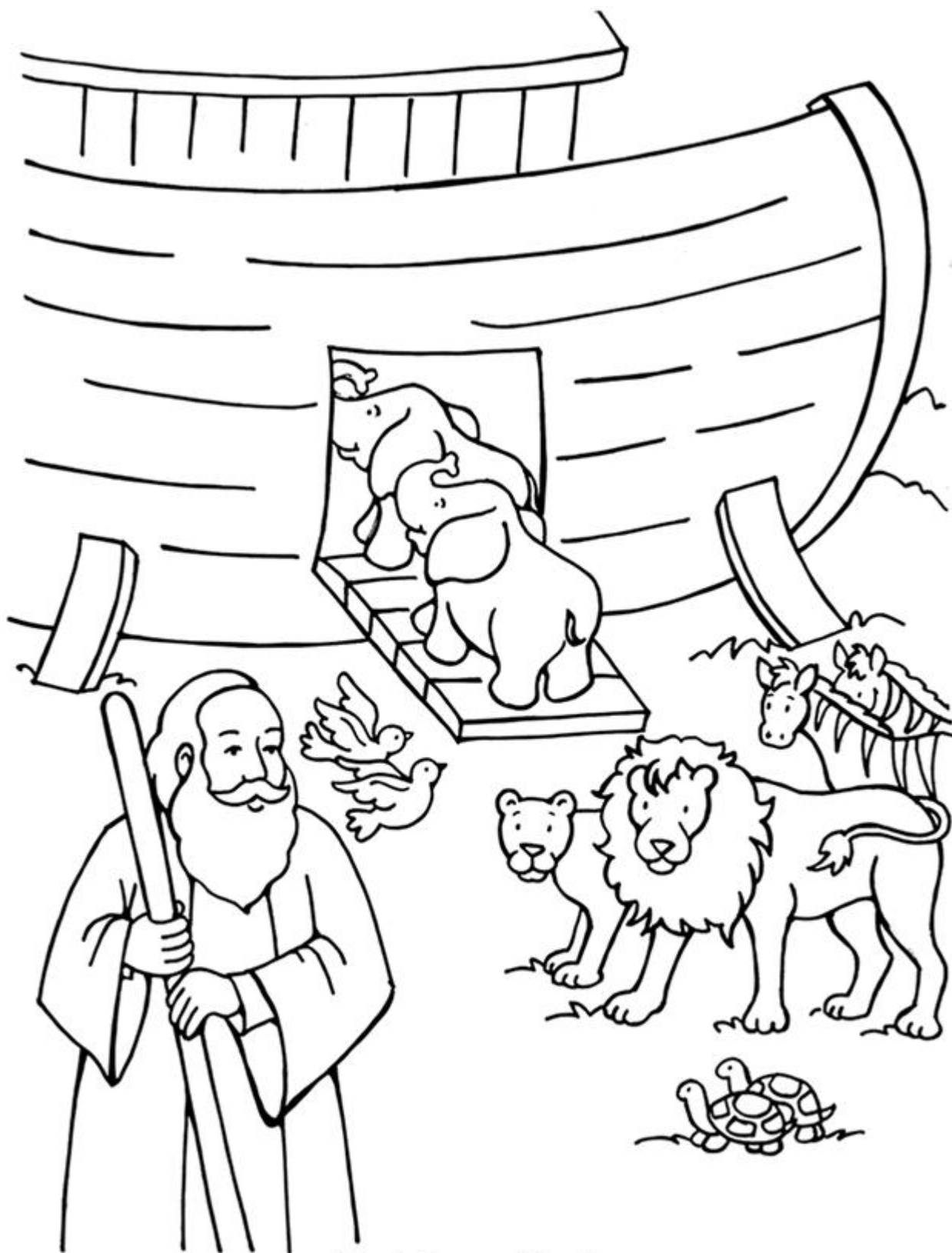
But God saw that Noah was different. God saw that Noah was a good man, so he decided that he would spare Noah and his family. God told Noah about his plan to send a great flood to destroy everything on the earth. He told Noah to build a big boat called an ark. God told Noah exactly how to build it. (Read Genesis 6:15-16) Then he told Noah after he had built the ark to fill it with animals -- two of every kind. Noah obeyed God. He built the boat and then he put two of every kind of animal into it. Then Noah and his family entered the ark and God shut the door.

Soon the rain began to fall. The raindrops made little puddles, then bigger puddles. The big puddles became streams and rivers, then mighty seas. Soon the whole earth was covered with water. Father, sometimes it seems that the job is too big for us. Help us to remember that when we put trust in you, anything is possible. Amen.



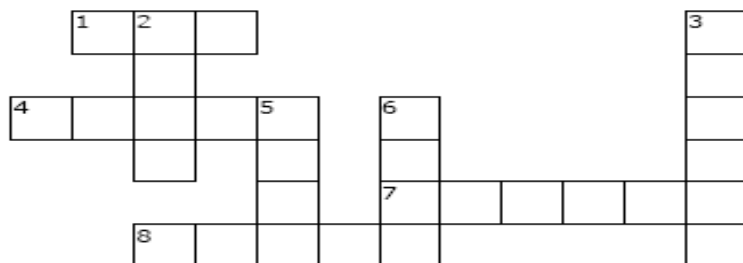

So make yourself an \_\_\_\_\_ of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with \_\_\_\_\_ inside and out. This is how you are to build it: The ark is to be 450 feet \_\_\_\_\_, 75 feet \_\_\_\_\_ and 45 feet \_\_\_\_\_. Make a roof for it and finish the ark to within 18 inches of the top. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks.

I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish. But I will establish my covenant with you, and \_\_\_\_\_ will enter the ark—you and your sons and your wife and your sons' wives with you. You are to bring into the ark \_\_\_\_\_ of all living creatures, male and female, to keep them alive with you. Two of every kind of bird, of every kind of animal and of every kind of creature that moves along the ground will come to you to be kept alive.
