Quick Summary of July 2018 Financial Information

Operating Fund – July receipts were \$24,403; disbursements were \$18,865 for net receipts of \$5,537. Year to date receipts were \$161,229; disbursements were \$159,977 for net receipts of \$1,252. The Operating Fund balance was \$11,886 at January 1, 2018 and was positive \$13,137 at July 31, 2018.

Building Fund – July receipts were \$2,469; disbursements were \$1,020 for net receipts of \$1,449. Year to date receipts were \$11,183; disbursements were \$7,140 for net receipts of \$4,043. The Building Fund balance was \$3,128 at January 1, 2018 and was \$7,170 at July 31, 2018.

Carpeting Fund – July receipts were \$40. There were no disbursements. Year to date receipts were \$5,318. There were no disbursements. The Carpeting Fund balance was negative (\$5,054) at January 1, 2018 and was \$264 at July 31, 2018.

Unrestricted Cash Balances – total \$82,885 as of July 31, 2018. The accounts are held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Restricted Cash Balances – Pynch Memorial Fund – is \$10,017 as of July 31, 2018. Principal of \$10,000 is to be maintained forever. Earnings on the account are to be used for kitchen supplies and library materials. The account is held at Investors Community Bank, Appleton, WI.

Mortgage Balance – The mortgage balance on July 31, 2018 is \$81,863. Payments of \$1,020 (principal and interest at 4.750 percent) are due on the 25th of each month. The final payment is due September 25, 2020. The mortgage is held by Investors Community Bank.




FAMILY MINISTRIES—NEXT ADVENTURES

Theme: Jesus alone has eternal life. Proper 16 (21) -

"Books, a backpack, or other items" it is time to go back to school.

Scripture: Then Jesus turned to the Twelve and asked, "Are you also going to leave?" Simon Peter replied, "Lord, to whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life." John 6:67-68



It is back to school time! Does that make you happy, or are you sad? Are you excited? Nervous? Afraid? You needn't be ashamed if you are a little bit nervous or afraid. After all, you will be facing a lot of new things. You will have to make a lot of choices. What are some of the choices you will have to make when you start back to school? (Allow time for the children to answer, but if they don't respond, here are some suggestions to get them started.) Well, if your school does not require uniforms, one of the first things you will have to choose is what you will wear the first day of school. That is pretty important, isn't it? After all, you want to look your best and make a good impression. When you get to your classroom, you will have to choose where you want to sit. Is it best to sit up front, at the back, or maybe somewhere in the middle? When it is time for lunch, you will have to choose what you want to eat in the cafeteria. Will you choose chicken nuggets or pizza?

Some choices you have to make are not very important, but others are very important. There will be rules in your classroom. You will have to choose whether or not you are going to follow the rules. That is very important! You will also be choosing who your friends will be. That is important, because if you choose the wrong kind of friends, you might find yourself in a lot of trouble. What if the teacher says something and you don't understand it? Will you pretend that you understand, or will you go to the teacher and ask for help? Those are some pretty important decisions you may be facing in the new school year.

The followers of Jesus faced some difficult decisions too. Sometimes, the teachings of Jesus were hard for them to understand. One day Jesus was teaching in the synagogue and he said to the people, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Anyone who feeds on me will live forever." When the people heard it, they said, "This is a hard teaching. How can anyone accept it?" Some of them quit following Jesus after that day.

Jesus knew that many people were grumbling and complaining, so he turned to the twelve whom he had chosen to be his disciples and said, "You don't want to leave too, do you?"

Peter answered him. "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God." The disciples had answered the call to follow Jesus. They were not about to turn back now.






