## Save the Date! "Help for the Homeless" hygiene drive Feb. 16 – March 8, 2020

Last spring 278 Fox Cities area businesses, churches and schools placed collection boxes with posters in their high traffic areas and encouraged their staff, members, students, and friends to donate hygiene supplies to local shelters for The Family Radio's annual "Help for the Homeless" hygiene drive. Their donations totaled \$163,000 worth of supplies for local Fox Cities crisis programs – thank you! The boxes will be set up on the 12th of February with a listing of items that can be donated.

The communities "get" this! Most of us CAN afford to buy an extra bottle of shampoo or package of toilet tissue. In 2019, \$406,000 worth of supplies were donated in Northeast and Central Wisconsin, stocking the shelves of 83 local crisis agencies. This donation allows our crisis agencies to concentrate their limited resources on providing qualified staff, safe housing, nutritious food, education, and counseling to those they serve.

**Please visit with your decision makers to participate in 2020.** \$1.3 Million dollars' worth of supplies have been donated to Fox Cities crisis programs since 2008!

Why: Hygiene and cleaning items are expensive and are not covered by Wisconsin Food Share (formerly Food Stamps). This donation helps BOTH the crisis programs and those they serve.

Where: The Family's Help for the Homeless hygiene drive takes place in 15 communities in our listening areas; Appleton/Fox Cities, Antigo, Chilton, Fond du Lac, Green Bay/Brown County, Manitowoc, Marshfield, Marathon County/Wausau, Oconto/ Marinette, Oshkosh, Seymour, Sheboygan, Stevens Point, Waupaca and Wisconsin Rapids. **Donations remain in communities where collected.** 

**How:** Local employers, churches, and schools place collection boxes in their high traffic areas and encourage their staff, members, students and friends to donate hygiene/cleaning products to help local crisis programs. The Family's Help for the Homeless web page website offers helpful promotional materials, flyers, and blurbs to copy into newsletters, memos etc. *Customized materials available upon request.* Your box and poster will be delivered to you before Feb.16 and picked up again by March 13.

You can run, but you can't hide from God......

Have any of you heard about a man named Jonah? (Let children respond.) Jonah was a prophet of God; he would listen to God and tell the people what God said. One day, God said to Jonah, "Go to the city of Nineveh and tell the people who live there that they are a very wicked people and that they need to change their ways." Jonah did not want to go to Nineveh. He didn't like the people in that city, and maybe he was afraid of them. So Jonah decided to run away and hide from God. He caught the first ship out of town and headed in the opposite direction from where God told him to go.

Well, Jonah learned a very important lesson that day. He learned that you might run from God, but you cannot hide. Jonah got on that ship and hid way down deep inside. "Surely God won't find me here," Jonah thought. But God sent a big storm and tossed that boat around so much that the other sailors thought they were going to drown. They found Jonah in the bottom of the ship and asked him, "Who are you and what are you doing here?"

Jonah answered, "I am a worshiper of the God of heaven, who made the land and the sea." Jonah went on to explain to the sailors that he was running from God because he didn't want to go to Nineveh as God had told him to do.

When the sailors learned that Jonah was running from God, the were even more afraid. "What should we do to stop this terrible storm?" the sailors asked.

"Throw me overboard into the sea," Jonah answered, "and the sea will become calm."

The sailors picked up Jonah and threw him into the sea and the storm stopped at once.

Our Father in heaven, we can't hide from you. You know what we do and what we think. Give us the strength and courage to do all the things that you want us to do. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
