In hinds sight the previous ministry events were training for leading Faith Church through the Disaffiliation process. Little did I ever imagine that I would be your Pastor through that process. God is good and He does have a sense of humor as to whom he calls and uses!

Now onto the season of being part of Faith Church, part 5, thank you for letting me be your Pastor for the last 14 years as we have been through a lot together. This is the longest tenured appointment that I have had. I leave Faith Church as its second longest tenured pastor. Thank you Faith Church! Thank you for the party on June 10th along with the lunch, the gifts and cards you gave Lori and I. Emotionally it was a lot to take in because I had never done that before. The last 45 days have been a blessing too. Thank you!

A time to weep and a time to dance. We are now two years past disaffiliation and in a good spot. A time to dance. A time to weep, closure is hard and it is always difficult to say Goodbye! I pray for Pastor Paul and his ministry with you as you go into a new season as Faith Global Methodist Church. It will be time to dance!

Today's lesson is based on a Bible verse that is so easy to learn. You are going to have it memorized by the time I am finished this morning. You will even be able today it backwards!

Oh, that's my cell phone. Excuse me, it may be important. Oh, hi, how are you? It is good to hear from you too. I know I'm sorry I haven't been in touch for a while. You know how crazy things get. Hey, I'm glad you called because I have been meaning to thank you for being there for me the other day. () Hey sorry, I got to go. I'm in church and I'm supposed to be teaching the children's message. Love you!

Sorry about that. Thanks for waiting so patiently. I have to admit at first I didn't think cell phones were necessary but I really like that I can keep in touch with my loved ones all the time. I have them on speed dial. I just push one number and radio signals find their phone and within seconds were connected. It is a great way to keep in touch. I call when I just want to talk or if I need help or guidance or if I am worried. I take it with me when I walk or am driving alone just incase I need to call for help. It makes me feel safer knowing I can get in touch with someone. When I was your age we just didn't have this kind of technology — it is amazing. Everywhere I go people are using their cell phones. These days' people are continually on their cell phones.

Back to our lesson - our Bible verse. Our Bible verse is from 1 Thessalonians 5:17 it says, "Pray continually." (Have children say it forward and backwards.) It has the same meaning either way you say it. This means the Lord wants to hear from us all the time. He wants to be thanked, he wants you to ask for help, and most importantly, he wants you to keep in touch. Now the Lord's technology for keeping in touch has been around forever and it is more advanced than any of our modern technology. There is no speed dial or cell phone necessary. You just call to him aloud or in your head and he is listening instantly!

Next time you see someone using a cell phone, think to yourself, "pray continually", 1 Thessalonians 5:17.
